With the help of Congresswoman Barbara Lee's office and the office of our Councilmember Dan Kalb, neighborhood representatives recently met with the West Coast Regional Real Estate Specialist for the US Postal Service from San Diego at Congresswoman Lee's Oakland office. The developer of the Post Office site has said they are willing to consider a retail P.O. on the ground floor of their project, but decisions by both sides are not yet final.
